Prepare yourself to be seen in the video

Create a set

When you're done making yourself presentable, try to find a space where you feel comfortable showcasing your skills, expertise and personality without distractions. Good light, ability to share your screen, hear given questions, take some notes and avoid interruptions when you are speaking.

Test your technology and get familiar with Google Hangouts

Make sure the technology being used for the virtual interview is installed and working before your meeting. Check your internet connection/phone reception ahead of schedule in case you need to reach out to someone for assistance, this isn't FaceTime with your grandma. Feel free to do this check as soon as you get the link to the interview, this will allow you to reach out to us in case something is not working correctly.

We use <u>Google Hangouts</u>, which allows you to connect via computer, tablet, or phone. And you easily access the interview by clicking on the link in your calendar invitation.

Focus on communication

To speak clearly and to articulate is extra important now during the virtual interviews. You also need to make sure you are able to understand the recruiter, so feel comfortable asking questions, or asking them to repeat themselves if you didn't hear clearly.

Be patient
